CONTEST PERIOD

Any likes/shares/favorites/retweets made after this time will not be counted. The winning entries will be announced online on Monday, July 20, 2015.

WHO MAY ENTER

Anyone from the 11th District may submit up to three (3) photos. You do not have to be a professional photographer or use professional equipment to participate.

PHOTO CRITERIA

Photos should include landscapes, cityscapes, architecture, and/or events. No selfies, please! All photos must be your own and taken in the 11th District within the last two years.

HOW TO ENTER

Each entry must include your name, address, telephone number, email address and (if applicable) your Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram usernames. Please also include the photo location, date taken, and names of any individual(s) captured in the photograph. **Late submissions will not be accepted.**

JUDGING

Photos will be screened prior to being posted online. My office reserves the right to exclude entries that are deemed inappropriate or do not meet the criteria for entry. Photos will also be judged on a five-point scale in three categories: (1) originality, (2) artistic merit, and (3) relevance to the contest. If more than 25 entries are received, only those with the highest scores will be posted for voting.
